

STATEMENT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION

The following actions were taken to correct each of the deficiencies noted during the vessel sanitation inspection conducted on board Radisson Seven Seas Cruises' vessel *m/s Seven Seas Navigator* on July 17 in Seward, Alaska.

1	*	0	No	Potable Water - Bunkering On 6/26/2002 bunkered water was not chlorinated at 2.0ppm. Chlorine levels were recorded to be 1.8ppm	All deck officers have been reminded that potable water shall be halogenated at 2.0ppm at the time of bunkering. It has been made a policy that the deck officer in charge of bunkering potable water verify the good working order of the halogenation device prior to the commencement of the bunkering of potable water.
2	*	0	No	Garbage Handling Room Deck taps and the supply line to the garbage chute should be labeled as potable water supply.	All taps and potable water supply lines were painted blue and have been labeled with signs saying "Potable Water".
3	*	0	No	Provision / Fish Prep The light level over the undercounter dishwashing machine appeared to be less than 220 lux.	The light intensity in that area was measured; it exceeded 20 foot candles.
4	*	0	No	Portofino Grill The carving station, when used, was placed in an area where access to the nearest handwashing station was greater than 8 meters (25 feet). There was an area on the buffet where the carving station may have originally been planned. This area would then provide access to the handwashing station behind the buffet line.	The carving station was moved back to its intended position, where access to a handwashing facility is within the mandated 8 meters (25 feet).

5	*	0	No	Galileo Bar The metered faucet for the handwashing station on the bar counter did not run for at least 15 seconds.	The metered faucet has been replaced with a new one that runs water for at least 25 seconds
6	*	0	No	General Comment The time management plan, food labeling, and temperatures were excellent.	No action required.
