





- ★ Develop data use agreement form






Summary Points: Call 1

- ★ Comparison across programs
 - Consistency
 - Ability to review data before publication
 - Child and environmental data
 - Footnote explanations for data interpretation
 - Explain differences as questions arise

- ★ Geographic level of data reported
 - Zip Code or Census Tract
 - County Level
 - County and Zip Code
 - State
- ★ Definitions
 - CSTE definition
 - Importance of standardization

- ★ Number and percent of children receiving screening blood lead tests, by state and year
- ★ BLL distribution of children screened, by state, year X
- ★ Number and percent of children screened, by state and selected sociodemographic characteristics, year X



Call 2: Sample Tables

- ★ Number and percent of children with current EBLLs ≥ 10 , by state and selected sociodemographic characteristics, year X
- ★ Number of children tested at least once by age 3, by state, 2000
